The practice of baptism began with John the Baptist and was affirmed by Jesus Christ. Throughout their ministries, baptism was consistently performed by full immersion in water. This method of baptism, deeply rooted in the biblical tradition, was not merely a symbolic act but a profound declaration of faith and repentance, as laid down by the author.

However, as with many doctrinal practices, variations have emerged over time. Some Christian traditions now practice alternative forms of baptism that deviate from the full immersion method. These alternatives, while doctrinally significant to those who practice them, differ from the original biblical foundation. There is no intention to judge any Christian sect, but think of it, we can all argue in support of whatever we like to do and that is why we need to return and uphold the foundation of baptism in the face of deviations.

If I were to choose between the foundation of baptism in the Holy Bible and derivatives or let's use the word, deviations, I will choose the foundation in the Bible as practiced by John and affirmed by Jesus. This is for the wise minds: every Christian doctrine has biblical quotes but might be a deviation from the position of God, and inherently formulated by humans for which agenda we may not know. When it comes to choosing a form of baptism, one must consider which practice aligns with Jesus' affirmation when he was in human form, if we follow Jesus indeed, then we should follow in details. If you are contemplating baptism or seeking a church community to get baptized, you might prefer any living church that practices full immersion in water, as established by John and Jesus' disciples. This approach maintains a direct connection to the biblical model and its symbolic significance.

As for re-baptism, my personal journey offers some insight. My initial baptism, performed when I was a young boy, was a doctrinal act that held little personal meaning. However, upon a genuine encounter with Jesus and a clearer understanding of salvation, I chose to be rebaptized with full awareness and intention. This choice was driven by a desire to ensure my baptism was meaningful and aligned with my faith journey.

For those baptized as infants, forced, following a doctrine without conviction for Christ's salvation or in any other context whereby it had no personal conviction for repentance and salvation to them, opting for a conscious, informed baptism by full immersion in water later in life can be a significant step. So, I believe in the possibility of rebaptism, provided it is done thoughtfully and with sincere intent. It is now important not to do it more than twice as it may signal an unserious soul. According to Hebrews 6:1, the foundational aspects of repentance and faith should be understood and embraced once the genuine personal conviction is there and not going back again. Re-baptism should not become a repetitive ritual but a reaffirmation of one's commitment to faith and understanding.

Kindly know or be reminded that we are not going to Heaven as misunderstood by many, but to the Kingdom of Heaven, also called the Kingdom of God, on the new earth. Surely, we shall all die from this world and there are remnants who would still be alive when Jesus shall return. God has sent salvation to mankind but we have the single requirement of accepting it. I encourage you to secure your soul for that coming time when both those alive at the time of Jesus' return and those who have all died shall be risen to Judgement.

It is the humans who received this salvation offer when alive that shall enter the Kingdom of God on the new earth because at the acceptance of the salvation, our names are written in the Book of Life. Those who didn't receive the salvation shall have their place with fallen angels in the eternal lake of fire according to Revelation chapter 20. We receive the salvation offer by genuine repentance from unGodly and unethical lifestyle (living), baptism and, remaining a disciple of Jesus Christ. If you accept this free offer of eternal life, I want to say congratulations and see you in the Kingdom of God.
